

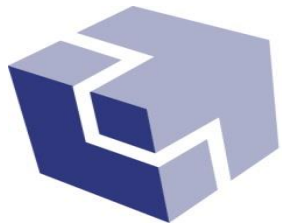

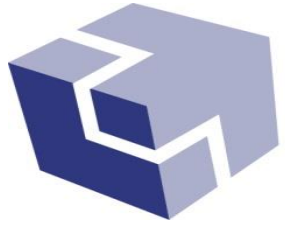
# Overview of CFW

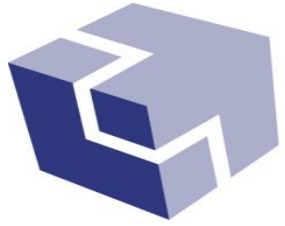

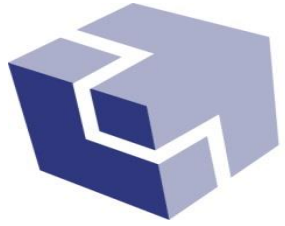
